"DYK (*Do You Know*) *Your Story?*"  
AT LOCAL MIDDLE SCHOOLS**

Syracuse, NY—Teen leaders from Prevention Network's *SQUAD—Students Questioning Underage Drinking*—will lead *DYK Your Story* workshops for middle school students tomorrow. Four CNY students will speak to 180 8<sup>th</sup> grade students during two workshops at Lincoln Middle School tomorrow morning, Thursday, May 17th. The presentations are scheduled to begin at 8:15am and 9:08am.

The students, including, Calvin Mitchell and Sonya McCarty of Fowler High School, Kristina Miranovic of West Genesee High School, and Dan Karper of LeMoyne College, will serve as mentors during the 45-minute presentations. The *SQUAD's Do you know your story?* workshops are designed to educate middle school children about the dangers of consuming alcohol and provide healthy alternatives and responses to peer pressure.
