Syracuse, NY—Prevention Network is co-sponsoring the second annual *Recovery Day* celebration, a free family event at the Syracuse Inner Harbor (corner of Solar and Kirkpatrick Streets) on Saturday, September 13, 2008, from 10am to 2pm. The celebration is being held in recognition of Recovery Month, which is observed in September each year. The agency has teamed up with several other local treatment organizations and individuals to host this special event. In doing so, sponsors hope to inform the community about the benefits of treatment for substance use disorders and its impact on families and neighborhoods, decrease the rate of local substance use, reduce stigma, and improve the lives of children and families affected by substance use disorders.
